## A Word from the Principal...

Timnath families,

I want to keep you in the loop about our upcoming October Count, including how it impacts the funding for our school.

PSD uses a student-based budgeting model (SBB), which means schools receive funding per student in attendance at their school. There are a lot of factors that go into how much we receive for each student, so it's not one set amount for every student in our building, but it's approximately \$4,000 per student. We use the funding we receive per student to pay for our staffing and for building operating costs.

The state of Colorado uses what's called "October Count" to verify how many students attend each school to determine the state funding that will go to each district. Our district then uses October Count numbers to determine budget allocations for each school. The state will look at our attendance **September 26<sup>th</sup> through October 10<sup>th</sup>**, with the official October Count date on **October 3<sup>rd</sup>**.

I am providing this information so you are informed about the way our funding works, and so you can help ensure we receive maximum funding. If you are planning trips or appointments that will affect your child's attendance, it is helpful if you avoid the October Count dates. It is always important for your child to attend school regularly, and these dates just have an additional level of importance because of the impact on our school funding. An important reminder from our Health Office is that all students must be up to date on their immunizations to attend school. If they are not up to date or we do not have an exemption on file, they will not be allowed to attend school starting November 1, 2018. The Larimer County Health Department will be having a vaccine clinic Saturday September 29, 2019 (see attached). Non-medical exemptions must be completed every school year. A final reminder to our families is regarding medications at school. ALL medications (prescription, over-the-counter, long-term or short-term, or asthma inhaler) require a PSD Authorization and Release to Administer Medication Form signed by both the prescribing practitioner and the parent/guardian. This includes cold medications and cough drops. The form must be signed by both the parent and prescribing practitioner each year.
