Thank you for the wonderful year! We are already looking ahead to next year, and you will find important information below about the 2019-2020 school year.

Kindergarten: The state will completely fund full-day kindergarten starting in the 2019-2020 school year, so there will no longer be tuition for full-day kindergarten. We will still provide a half-day option via an embedded model within the full-day classrooms.

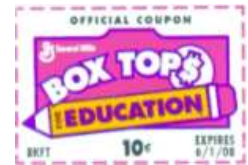

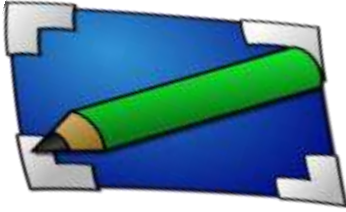
